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DETAILED PROCEDURE FOR LATERAL ENTRY ADMISSION-2025

Indian Maritime University invites applications from eligible candidates fulfilling the educational and other eligibility criteria for the UG program at its Kolkata Campus through the lateral entry scheme.

It is proposed to fill the seats available for the B Tech (Marine Engineering) program being conducted at **IMU, Kolkata campus for Academic Year 2025-2026 through Lateral Entry Scheme (direct admission into 2nd year).**

The duration will be three academic years consisting of six semesters of course work. For details of the program and fees please refer to the academic brochure for 2025-2026 available at www.imu.edu.in.

(i)	Eligibility – Educational	<p>3-years Engineering Diploma in Marine/ Mechanical / Electrical /Electrical &Electronics from the colleges approved by AICTE or State Board of Technical Education with minimum 55% of aggregate marks in the last year of Diploma Course.</p> <p>OR</p> <p>4 years Diploma in Shipbuilding Engineering from the colleges approved by AICTE or State Board of Technical Education with minimum 55% aggregate marks in the last year of diploma course</p> <p>OR</p> <p>1st year training from the Alternate Training Scheme, approved by D.G.Shipping (This will not be applicable to MERI).</p> <p>OR</p> <p>1st year from the Engineering College in other streams like Mechanical or Electrical approved by AICTE with minimum 60% average marks.</p> <p>OR</p> <p>3years Diploma Course in the following categories, from the colleges approved by AICTE or State Board of Technical Education with minimum 55% of aggregate marks in the last year of Diploma Course:</p> <p>a) <u>Mechanical Engineering Stream</u> : Automobile/Machine Tools and Maintenance/Plant Engineering/Production Technology/Production Engineering/Advanced Diploma in Tool and Die Making.</p> <p>b) <u>Electrical Engineering Stream</u>: Electrical Power System</p> <p>c) <u>Electrical and Electronics Engineering Stream</u>: Digital Electronics/ Electronics and Communications/Electronics & Telecommunication/ Industrial Electronics/ Electronics/ Electronics Production & Maintenance/ Instrumentation /Instrumentation & Control Engineering</p> <p>AND</p> <p>The candidate must have secured a minimum of 50% marks in English language at 10th or 12th or in the Degree/Diploma Course conducted by a recognized board or University.</p>
(ii)	Age Criteria (as on Joining date)	<p>Maximum age: For Male: Gen-25 years, OBC(NCL)-28 years, SC/ST-30 years</p> <p>For Female: Gen-27 years, OBC(NCL)-30 years, SC/ST-32 years. The reference date for calculation of the age will be from the date of commencement of the academic session.</p>
(ii)	Eligibility	Physical Fitness: Candidates seeking admission to the these Marine Programmes

i)	– Medical	must be medically fit including eye sight and hearing as prescribed in the Merchant Shipping (Medical Examination) Rules, 2000, as amended. At the time of admission, candidates will be required to produce certificate of medical fitness issued by doctors approved by the Directorate General of Shipping, Mumbai. Eye sight : There shall be no evidence of any morbid condition of either eye or of the lids of either eye which may be liable to risk of aggravation or recurrence. Candidates must possess good binocular vision (Fusion faculty and full field of vision in both eyes). Movement of the eyeballs must be full in all directions and the pupils should react normally to light and accommodation. Normal colour vision shall be tested by Ishihara test chart. Distance Vision unaided 0.5*(6/12) in each eye or 0.67*(6/9) in better eye and 0.33*(6/18) in other eye. At the time of admission, candidates will be required to produce certificate of medical fitness issued by doctors approved by the Directorate General of Shipping. 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2. **No. of seats vacant:** Total No of seats vacant are **09** and admissions will be made in the order of merit based on aggregate percentage of marks in their respective Degree/Diploma following the rule of reservation. The shortlisted candidates will be intimated by email and the same list will be uploaded in **www.imukolkata.edu.in**

3. **Procedure to follow:**

A. Interested candidates should download the application form from **www.imu.edu.in** , **www.imukolkata.edu.in** and submit the same along with self-attested copies of certificates and mark sheets by post or scanned copies of certificates and documents through e-mail at trng.kolkata@imu.ac.in so as to reach the following address on or before **30th June, 2025**

An Application Fee for Rs.1000/- for General/OBC candidates and **Rs.700/-** for schedule Caste /Scheduled Tribe candidates to be paid along with the submission of application in the form of **Demand draft payable at Kolkata** in favour of **Indian Maritime University, Kolkata campus.**

The applications received will be scrutinised category wise based on the age and qualifying educational criterion and shortlisted based on merit only. The list of shortlisted and waitlist candidates will be put up in the website **www.imukolkata.edu.in**. The shortlisted candidates will also be intimated by e-mail.

B. The shortlisted candidates will be required to report at **IMU, Kolkata Campus** for verification of certificates & counselling on the date which will be intimated later through email as well as the same will be uploaded in **www.imukolkata.edu.in** portal.

The following certificates should be produced in original at the time of counselling.

- I. SSC / 10th Standard Mark sheet (for proof of date of birth)
- II. Provisional Certificate / Degree or Diploma Certificate as applicable

- III. Course Completion Certificate (if provisional certificate is not issued)
- IV. Statement of Marks of all Semester / Academic Years.
- V. Approved Medical Fitness Certificate from DGS approved doctors complying with MS Act.
- VI. Caste Certificate, if applicable.
- VII. Photocopy of Indian Passport (all candidates require a PASSPORT for joining the course and for obtaining Indian National Database of Seafarers (INDOS Number).
- VIII. Photocopy of aadhar Card
- IX. Passport size photo with white background.

C. After verification of certificates, the candidate will be issued the admission letter subject to submission of fees.

D. IMU reserves the right to allocate any leftover seats in any category to waitlisted candidates in that category or to any other remaining categories.

E. The Selected candidates will have to report at IMU, Kolkata Campus and register for the 3rd semester starting on 1st Aug, 2025.

4. **Fee to be paid after Confirmation of Admission:**
